

Amendments to the EU Regulations on the Classification, Labelling & Packaging of Chemicals - Nov 2024

Additional information on Peel & Reveal Labels

The front page of the fold-out label shall include at least the following elements:

- ◆ the name, address and phone number of suppliers
- ◆ nominal quantity of the substance or mixture in the package made available to the general public, unless this quantity is specified elsewhere on the package
- ◆ the product identifiers in accordance with Article 18(2) for substances and Article 18(3)(a) for mixtures in all languages of the label that are used in the inside pages
- ◆ where applicable, the hazard pictograms
- ◆ where applicable, the signal words in all languages of the label that are used in the inside pages
- ◆ where applicable, the unique formula identifier, unless printed or affixed on the inner packaging in accordance with Part A, point 5.3, of Annex VIII to this Regulation
- ◆ a reference to the full safety information inside the fold-out label in all languages of the label or a symbol to inform a user that the label can be opened and to illustrate that additional information is available on the inside pages
- ◆ an abbreviation of the language (country code or language code) for all the languages that are used in the inside pages.

The inner pages of the fold-out label shall contain all the label elements provided for in Article 17(1), except for the hazard pictogram and the supplier identification, in each of the languages mentioned on the front page and grouped by language, using the language abbreviation (country code or language code).

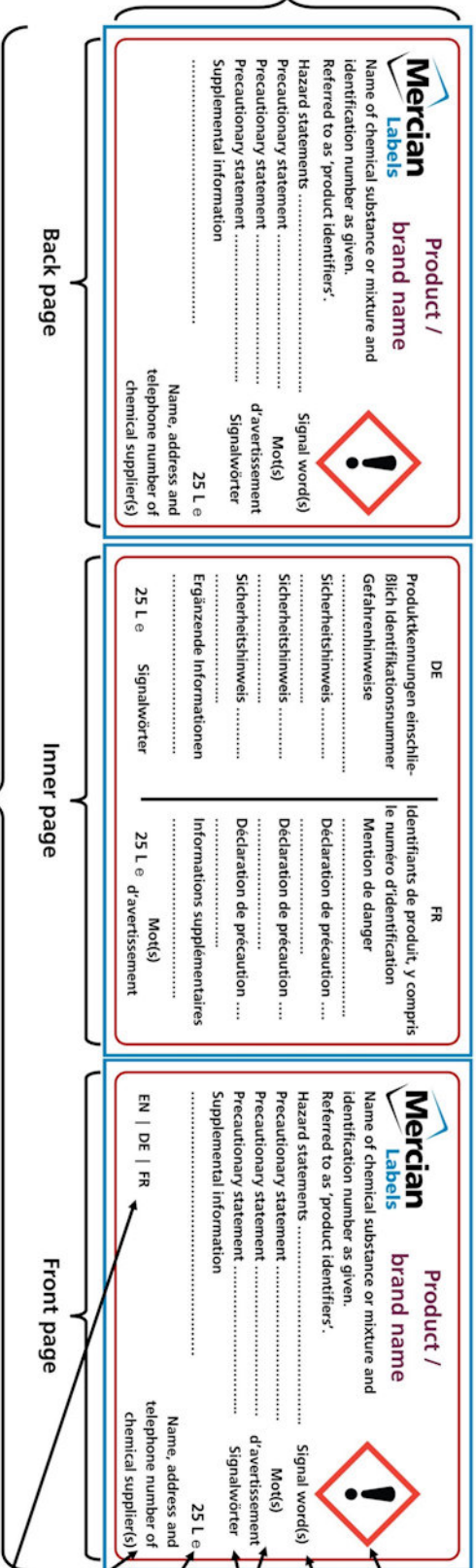
The back page of the fold-out label shall contain all the label elements provided on the front page, except for the abbreviations of the languages that are used on the inside pages.

Peel & Reveal Label for EU Chemicals - Worked Example

Example highlighting the requirements for Peel & Reveal labels on chemical products with a packaging capacity greater than 3 litres, but not exceeding 50 litres

Minimum label size / area (to red line) of at least 74 x 105mm required to display all text required under Article 17(1)



All text required under Article 17(1) must appear in black on a white background

The same font, and always being one that is easily legible and without serifs, shall be used throughout and the letter spacing shall be appropriate for the selected font to be easily legible

- Pictogram size of at least 23 x 23mm
- Minimum font size with the x-height of at least 1.8mm
- Signal word(s) in all languages used on the inside page
- Signal word(s) in all languages used on the inside page
- Nominal quantity of the substance or mixture in the package
- Distance between two lines shall be at least 120% of the font size
- Country code(s) for languages used on the inside page(s)
